Requirements to Zip:

A sense of adventure.

Guests don't need special skills, training or equipment to enjoy zip lining. ZipZone provides the gear and highly trained guides to navigate and facilitate every zip so guests can enjoy an exhilarating experience from the treetops.

All guests must be at least 8-years-old/50 lbs. (maximum weight 250 lbs.)

The Cost: For a two-hour guided tour on five different zip lines and four sky bridges:

- \$64 per person weekdays (Monday-Thursday)
- \$69 per person weekends (Friday-Sunday)
- Groups of eight (8) or more can save \$10 per person
- Military personnel with proper ID can save 10 percent
